

DECLARATION OF AVANTIKA CHANDER

AVANTIKA CHANDER, being duly sworn under penalty of perjury, declares that the following is true and correct:

1. I am a registered voter in Pennsylvania.
2. I am 28 years old, and have voted in every Presidential election since I became eligible to vote.
3. I have a full-time job as a physician at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania.
4. I fully intend to vote in the election on November 4, 2008.
5. Voting in presidential elections is very important to me.
6. I will be on call at the hospital on Election Day, however, working a 30-hour shift from 7 a.m. on November 4th to 1 p.m. on November 5th.
7. I will do everything that I can to ensure that I am able to cast my ballot on November 4, 2008, but I am worried that there may be problems at my precinct that would hinder my ability to vote.
8. Because the voting precincts will not be open until 7 a.m. on Election Day and my shift at the hospital also begins at 7 a.m., I must vote first thing in the morning and will only be allowed to be slightly delayed for my shift that day, so if the voting machines break down at my precinct on Election Day and there are length delays, I will be denied my fundamental right to vote.
9. My work responsibilities would make it impossible for me to wait in a very long line to vote, especially if that long line was due to a non-operational machine and no one knew when it would be fixed, and if voters did not have access to emergency paper ballots.

10. I declare that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
